

Beyond the Red Door Society Pledge Levels

Gift of Friendship

The first level of giving in the Beyond the Red Door Society is a pledge of \$1000 a year, for five years. Your “Gift of Friendship” will support the participation of one individual in our cancer support program for one year. On average, a Gilda’s Club member will attend the Clubhouse 11 times in a year to connect with others going through similar experiences through their participation in educational lectures, interactive workshops, support groups and a variety of social activities.

Gift of Empowerment

The second level in the Beyond the Red Door Society is a gift of \$5000 a year, for five years. The “Gift of Empowerment” will help to ensure the ongoing offering of weekly, bi-weekly and monthly support and networking groups at Gilda’s Club Simcoe Muskoka. Whether it is Living with Loss, Family and Friends, Wellness or Metastatic and Recurrent, these are but a few of the over 200 groups offered each year for those in our community whose lives have been impacted by cancer. With close to 7,700 people in Simcoe County, York Region and the District of Muskoka being diagnosed with cancer this year, these groups are an integral part of our program of personalized support.

Gift of Laughter

The third level in the Beyond the Red Door Society is the “Gift of Laughter.” Honouring the memory of Gilda Radner, whose honesty and humour in her own journey with cancer inspired the creation of Gilda’s Club Worldwide, this commitment of \$10,000 a year for five years will make a significant contribution towards the cost of providing programming specifically for children, youth and families. When someone you care about is diagnosed with cancer, you too live with the rippling impact of this diagnosis. No more so is this true for families, and for children who call upon us daily for support and understanding, and the opportunity to express the rollercoaster of emotions as they learn to live with cancer in their lives.
