We are Brendon and Leslie, and we became members at Gilda's Club Simcoe Muskoka this past year.

Several years ago our daughter Shannon was diagnosed with colon cancer at age 31. At the time we were living in Vancouver, and soon decided we needed to live closer to help our daughter. Helping Shannon became a full time effort for both of us. Constant trips to treatments in Toronto, doctors appointments, just helping her with daily living - we were devoted to her. Unfortunately this past summer Shannon passed away from her disease at age 36. Along with the unimaginable loss of our daughter came another huge hole in our lives. We had

no sense of community or belonging anywhere. Then we found Gilda's Club.

The program activities and sense of community at Gilda's Club have been amazing for us. We had no idea it was also a place for the friends and families of people with a cancer diagnosis. How we wish we had learned about Gilda's Club while Shannon was still with us. She would have so enjoyed coming to the clubhouse with us to be a part of the many groups and activities offered.

The art classes would have been one of Shannon's favourite activities. She would have enjoyed the chance to focus on something creative and different, even for a little while.

Gilda's Club gives you the opportunity to connect with other people who truly understand what you are dealing with, because they are on the same journey as you. This is truly a place where "you can be you". No judgement, no funny looks, no feeling bad because today you just want to be sad.

We know there are many families out there with stories like ours, and we invite anyone touched by cancer to experience Gilda's Club the way we have.
