Full vaccine details and clinics are available at the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit website, but for our immune-compromised community this phase starts today and runs to end of July, depending on vaccine supply. Here are Phase 2 eligibility details from the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit.

Primary Priority

- Adults aged 60-79, starting with those 75-79 and decreasing in 5-year increments
- Individuals with health conditions, starting with Highest Risk and High-Risk health conditions
- Residents, Essential Caregivers and Staff of High-Risk Congregate Settings
- Adults aged 50+ in COVID-19 Hot Spot Communities, starting with older individuals and decreasing in age

Secondary Priority

Remaining Individuals with At-Risk Health Condition
 Essential Workers who cannot work from home

What does this mean for our Cancer Support Program? Variants of Concern, community transmission, and vaccinations for staff and facilitators are on still on an uncertain timeline, but we share the enthusiasm for a safe return to programming and support.


