

# When can I get a COVID-19 vaccine?

Beginning on March 1, people who belong to one of the <u>Phase 1 priority groups</u> are eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. As vaccine doses are limited, The Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit continues to focus on local residents based on high risk priority and therefore are starting to vaccinate specific age ranges in some of the priority groups. They will continue to update this information.

- Adults 80 years of age and older. At this time, only adults 85 years of age and older are eligible to book an appointment locally.
- All Indigenous adults. At this time, only Indigenous adults 55 years of age and older and their adult household members 16 years of age and older (Indigenous or non-Indigenous) are eligible to book an appointment locally.
- · Adult recipients of chronic home care.
- Staff, residents and caregivers in other congregate care settings for seniors (i.e. assisted living).
- Mobile clinics will be used to vaccinate these individuals.
- Very High Priority frontline health care workers in accordance with the <u>Ministry of</u> Health's Guidance on Health Care Worker Prioritization

Community clinics throughout Simcoe and Muskoka will be ready to open March 1<sup>st</sup>, pending supply of the vaccine. Clinics will be by appointment only and will focus on serving priority groups as identified in Ontario's guidance and SMDHU's own prioritization framework as vaccine supply becomes more readily available.


